Required qualification for Eligibility of Different Grades of Membership

1) Fellow:

Any candidate for election as a fellow or for transfer from Member to Fellow shall satisfy the Council:-

- i) that he is not less than 40 years of age on the date of application for election or transfer.
- ii) that he is engaged in the profession of engineering or science or technology in a position of high responsibility, or has retired from this profession after having held a position of high responsibility.
- iii) that he has at least one of the following qualifications:
 - a) He shall have high educations qualifications and shall occupy a prominent position in the profession of engineering or science or technology.
 - b) He shall have either remained as a Member for at least five years or shall have fulfilled the conditions for membership and he shall have at least 15 years employment in a position of responsibility, out of which 10 years should be in a position of high responsibility in the profession of science or engineering or technology and has submitted a thesis to the satisfaction of the Council.

Note: For considering these requirements teaching or research in engineering or science or technology may be considered as a position of high responsibility.

2) Member:

Any candidate for election as a Member or for transfer from Associate Member shall satisfy the Council:-

- i) that he is not less than 30 years of age on the date of Application for election or transfer.
- ii) that he is engaged in the profession of engineering or science or technology in a position of responsibility, or has retired from this profession after having held a position of responsibility.
- iii) that he has at least one of the following qualifications:
 - a) He shall have passed a degree examination in any branch of Engineering from any Indian University or any other foreign University or shall have passed the Associate Membership Examination Sections A & B of the Institution of Engineers (India) or any other recognized Professional Institution and he shall have held at least five years practical experience in a position of responsibility in the profession of engineering or science or technology.
 - b) He shall have either remained as an Associate Member for at least five years and through practical experience and ability, acquired distinction in the field of engineering or science or technology or shall have passed the Associate Membership Sections A & B examinations conducted by the Society and he shall have held at least 10 years practical experience holding a position of responsibility in the profession of engineering or science or technology.

3) Associate Member:

Any candidate for election as an Associate Member or for transfer from Licentiate Member to Associate Member shall satisfy the Council :-

- i) that he is not less than 25 years of age on the date of application or transfer.
- ii) that he shall be engaged in the profession of engineering or science or technology in a position of responsibility.
- iii) that he shall have passed a Diploma examination in any branch of Engineering held by any State Council of Engineering and Technical Education in the Indian Union or shall have passed Section - A Examination of the Institution of Engineers (India) or any other recognized professional Institution and shall have had at least two years practical experience in the profession of engineering or science or technology.
- iv) that he shall have passed Sections A & B Associate Membership Examination conducted by the Society and shall have had at least two years practical experience in the profession of engineering or science or technology to the satisfaction of the Council of the Society.

4) Licentiate:

Any candidate for election as a Licentiate or for transfer from Student to Licentiate shall satisfy the Council:

- i) that he is not less than the age of 20 years on the date of application for election or for transfer.
- ii) that he shall be engaged in the profession of engineering or science or technology.
- iii) that he shall have passed the technical examination/training in any branch of engineering, conducted by the institutes under control of the Central/State Government (s) or shall have passed in any branch of engineering from any affiliated Institutions of the society or any other registered Institutions, under societies' registration act, as deemed sufficient by the Council of the Society and shall have had at least two years practical experience in the profession of engineering or science or technology.
- iv) Licentiate of five years standing may be eligible for election as an Associate Member of application along with the prescribed fees subject to the approval of the council of the Society or he may appear in Sections A & B of Associate Membership Examinations conducted by the Society for direct election as an associate Member.

5) Student:

Any candidate for election as a student shall satisfy the Council :-

- i) that he is not less than the age of 16 years on the date of election.
- ii) that he shall be engaged in the profession of engineering or science or technology.
- iii) that he shall have passed School final/SSLC/ Higher Secondary or equivalent examination of the recognized Board or University of India or abroad.
- iv) A student will be required to pass the qualifying examination for election as an Associate Member of the Society as stated in 3 (iv).

Note: Students of the recognized engineering Diploma Course may also apply for studentship of the Society.

7) The Annual Subscription:

- a) Any person elected to any grade of Membership of the Society shall be liable to pay the Annual Subscription (as given below), until he resigns from his membership in writing after clearing of the arrears including the current year's subscription or until he has forfeited his right to remain in the Society as a member.
(i) Fellow: Rs. 700.00, (ii) Member: Rs. 500.00, (iii) Associate Member: Rs. 300.00,
(iv) Licentiate: Rs. 300.00, (v) Student: Rs. 200.00
- b) Annual subscription for the current year shall not have been paid before the first day of first month of the financial year shall be in "Arrear of Subscription". If such arrears have not been paid by the last day of September following, he will cease to receive copies of the Society Journal or enjoy Library service and other benefits.
- c) If any member of any grade leave the Annual subscription in arrear for two years and fail to clear it off within 6 (six) months from the date of a Notice served on him by the General Secretary, his name shall be removed from the roll of the Society and he will cease to have the rights and privileges of the members.
- d) Any person who has ceased to be a member of the Society either by resignation or by expulsion shall be liable to return immediately his Diploma or Certificate to the General Secretary either in person or through registered post, such person shall not be entitled to make use of any designation implying post connection with the Society.

8) The Life Membership Fees :

The Life Membership Fees for all categories of Members except Hony. Patron/Hony. Fellow and student shall be as per the following Table based on Age-Slab.

6) Election of New Members:

- a) The Council reserves the right to entertain or to refuse any application for Fellow, Member, Associate Member, Licentiate, Student and Institutional member without showing any reason what so ever.
 - b) Election to the following categories of Membership shall be made by the Council as its discretion without formal application:-
 - i) Honoray Parton
 - ii) Honoray Fellow
 - c) Election to the other categories of membership shall be made on an application prescribed by the Society. Candidates desirous to become members should submit the application from duly supported and verified by two Corporate Members, out of them one must be Fellow or Member, alongwith attested true copies of testimonials and necessary fees prescribed by the Society, in special cases, the application may be supported by the employer or Superior Officer under whom the applicant serves and by a Gazette Officer.
 - d) A Candidate for transfer from one grade of Membership to another grade shall submit the prescribed application form alongwith necessary fees and attested true copies of testimonials.
 - e) In case of rejection of any application of any category of Membership, a sum of Rs. 100/- will be deducted from the deposited money for office expenses and the rest amount will be refunded.

GENERAL NOTE:

(Please follow the General Note before filling the Application Form)

- a) Application Form should be filled in properly with Full Signature of Applicant and date.
- b) Educational Qualification: General Education (SSC/SSLC/H.S. etc.) and Technical Education (Degree/Diploma etc.) should be furnished on the Application Form on Column No. 1 (a) & (b).
- c) Professional Carrer up-to-date: i) Apprenticeship, ii) Service experience should be filled in the application form in Column No.: 2.
- d) Application Form must be supported in Column No. 1 & 2 on the First Page and in the supporters column on the Second Page by two Corporate Members of the Society (Fellow/Member/Associate Member) or Superior Engineer Officer or Employer or any other Gazette Engineer Officer and the supporter must sign under his Office Seal.
- e) All testimonial (General and Technical Education, Age Proof and Service experience etc.) attested by any Gazeted Officer under his Office Seal and additional paper (if any) must be enclosed along with the Application Form.
- f) Application Form should accompany the required Membership fees alongwith Annual Subscription by Demand Draft on a Bank at Kolkata infavour of "INDIA SOCIETY OF ENGINEERS"
